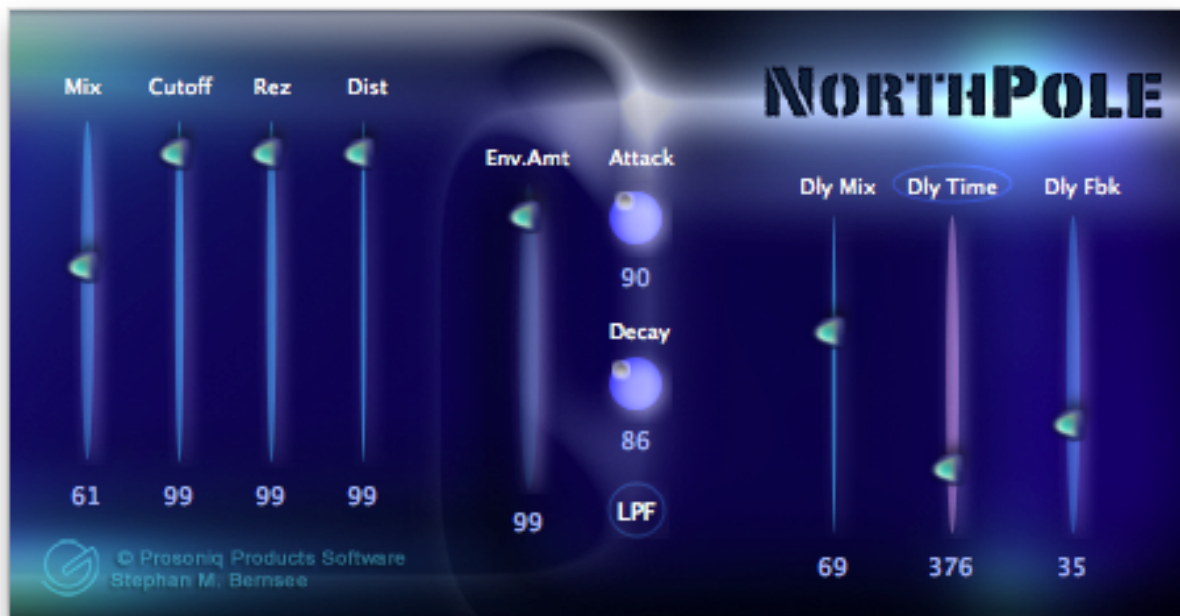


# Prosoniq NorthPole™ - Virtual Analog Filter

For AudioUnit compatible host applications



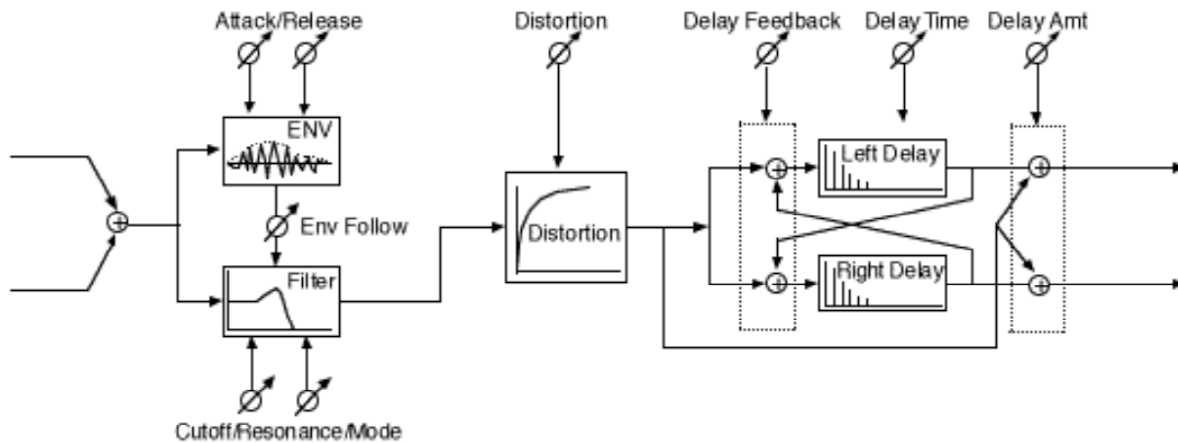
## What is it?

NorthPole™ is a free effects plug in for AudioUnit compatible applications on the Macintosh. It adds a fully programmable virtual analog synthesizer filter with resonance, envelope follower and an integrated post-filter digital delay to your audio production environment.

## Features

This free plug in equips your AudioUnit environment with a fully programmable resonant filter. In short, you can send any of your audio tracks through this 'virtual analog' effects device to either create special effects or to simulate the behaviour of an analog 4-pole synthesizer filter.

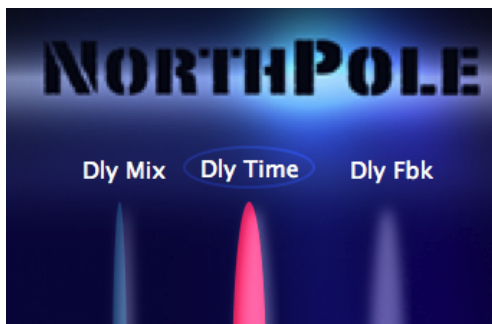
## NorthPole™ Resonant Filter Signal Path



It has the following specifications:

- 24dB/Octave (4 pole)
- variable Cutoff + Resonance
- Lowpass/Bandpass switchable
- Envelope Follower with adjustable sensitivity
- Envelope attack/release times
- Adjustable analog distortion
- Adjustable digital delay after filter with time, mix and feedback

This plug in is completely free and works without limitation.



### **New in 1.01:**

Repeatedly clicking on the "Dly Time" text area directly above the delay time slider sets the delay time to the time interval between the clicks. This "tap tempo" feature comes in handy when adjusting the tempo of the delay

**New in 1.02:**

NorthPole is now using a true stereo filter algorithm.

**New in 1.03 (25-05-2009):**

Updated code that handles the Carbon UI.

Speed improvements (approx. 2x faster than previous versions)

Fixed missing save/restoreGraphicsState calls

Changed UI layout to be compatible with Live 8.05

Fixed initialization and Cocoa namespace bugs

Added backwards compatibility with Logic 7

On Carbon-only hosts clicking the Cocoa window activates the underlying Carbon window as well

On Carbon-only hosts using regular (ie. non-floating palette) windows for displaying the plug in user interface, key events are now handled correctly

On Carbon-only hosts holding down the "control" key while opening the plug in editor now displays the user interface in a separate window.

**New in 1.22 (08-11-2010)**

Ported everything to 10.6 and Xcode 3.2.4. Fixed problem with Carbon/Cocoa overlay. Cleaned up code.

**New in 1.23 (10-11-2010)**

Fixed crash on MacOS X 10.5

Added 32/64bit Cocoa native version.

**New in 1.25 (06-09-2012)**

Code cleanup and Mountain Lion testing

**Installation**

All you need to do in order to use this plug in is to copy it to the appropriate plugins folder on your harddisk, usually this is /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components or ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components. After restarting your AudioUnit compatible host application, the 'NorthPole' plug in will show up in the list of modules in the effects rack.
