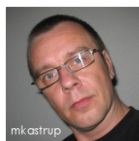

The ST CHORUS is my idea of a good sounding chorus. My preference for making this chorus comes mainly from my days working with various Roland effects like Dimension D, RE-301, Jazz Chorus Amp, Juno 60, Boss Pedals etc.... I wanted a broad stereo chorus which adds the smear phasing effects without losing its dynamics.

ST CHORUS primary target of use is with older mono VST synths or synths which comes with a somewhat weak chorus, but it might have use in other places.

Introduction

The holy grail of the various vintage chorus have been tried copied for years. My chorus experiment started 2 years ago but I stopped development because I found myself buried in sound design for various synths, also I figured that someone eventually would bring out a chorus I liked. Some new chorus have popped up in that time but when I turn to my old SE chorus project I still find that this is what I like best in a chorus. So what else is there to do than wrap it up and finish the project.

I'm afraid this plugin will only exist as long as something support plugins created with SynthEdit. My knowledge of advanced programming is limited to putting Hello World on the screen ;o) So yes, SynthEdit was a great help here.

The plugin comes with 14 factory settings and 18 default settings which should be enough for you to create your own favourite settings.

Installation

Unpack the ZIP file. Copy the SynthTronic directory with its files to your VSTplugins folder and you are set to go.

Like somewhere on my comp.. \Cubase 4\VSTplugins\FX\SynthTronic

If you are unsure where that somewhere is then try do a search for "VST" files on your comp, then something VST like is bound to show up.

Some tips

1. Experiment with different sound sources.
2. Experiments with the knobs and buttons, don't assume its all chorus coming out.
3. Using Ch Mode II smears the sound even more.

That's about it, have fun
